LRC Tunnel Paint Project Policies and Procedures

The Center for Student Enrichment in conjunction with ASNMU work together to ensure active student organizations can express their creativity on NMU's campus. They also recognize that many students have the skills needed to plan and complete high quality paint projects and support their interest in personalizing and decorating the LRC Tunnel. High quality paint projects add character, identity, and life to NMU's campus and make those areas more attractive for those who walk through them.

Goals

The overall goal for this policy is to have students complete paint projects that become a clear part of identity on this campus, are valued and respected by current and future students, and compliment the rest of the University's efforts to provide attractive facilities for students and visitors.

A second goal is to involve as many students from the various student organizations wishing to complete paint projects in the various aspects of these projects as is feasible.

General Project Conditions: Approval

- 1. The student organization must be a registered student organization with the Center for Student Enrichment (reference CSE website)
- 2. The student organization must have established members and be planning for long-term existence.
- 3. The paint project must be aesthetically pleasing and a good representation of the student organization.
- 4. The student organization looking to implement a paint project must submit all application materials for approval to ASNMU.
- 5. Please note that no student organization is allowed to use spray paint to complete any portion of their paint project in the LRC Tunnel.

General Project Conditions: Removal

- 1. If the organization's name has changed.
- 2. If the organization is no longer in existence at Northern Michigan University.
- 3. If the organization's painting is older than 5 years.
- 4. If the organization's painting isn't aesthetically pleasing.

Project Implementation

After being approved by the ASNMU General Assembly, the project plan can be implemented.
