

UNDERSTANDING YOUR

TRANSFER CREDIT EVALUATION (TCE)



HEADER



DATE AND TERM CODE

The date listed is when your TCE was sent to be printed. The six digit code below that is the term in which your TCE was processed. It is in the format of the first 4 numbers being the calendar year (e.g. 2022) and the last two are the semester (10=Winter, 50=Summer, 80=Fall). Need to change your start term? Just let us know!



YOUR INFORMATION

Your name and 8-digit NMUIN will be listed here. This is how we identify you at NMU in your student accounts.



EXTERNAL COLLEGE NAME

The name of the institution these credits are from will appear here. If you are transferring courses from more than one institution, you will receive a TCE for each school.



ATTENDANCE DATES & DEGREES AWARDED

These are the dates you had enrollment at the previous institution as indicated by the official transcript evaluated. The acceptance date is the date NMU offered admission. MMU does not post any externally awarded degrees (e.g. Associate of Arts) to the TCE.

TRANSFER COURSES & INSTITUTION EQUIVALENT

The left side courses are the classes you took at your previous institution. The right side indicates how the transfer course comes into NMU. The courses are indicated by grade-level (UG=undergraduate), subject code (e.g. ACT), course number (e.g. 230), course title, and credit hours for the course.



CREDIT HOURS

Credit hours for prior courses and NMU courses are listed in semester hours. Quarter hours will automatically be converted to semester hours for you. The credit hour is exact to the amount listed on your transcript, or to the quarter-semester conversion.



PRIOR COURSES

These are the subject codes, course numbers, credit hours, and grades indicated on your official transcripts from the previous school.



DIRECT EQUIVALENCY

Your prior course is equal to an exact NMU course.



GENERAL SUBJECT AREA CREDIT

If a course matches a department at NMU, but not a specific course, it will be listed as course 1009 in the subject (e.g. HP 1009).



COURSE NOT ACCEPTED

Courses that do not meet NMU's general transfer credit policy will not be accepted for transfer or awarded NMU credit.

TRANSFER LEVEL ATTEMPTED HOURS

These are the total attempted semester credit hours from the previous transfer institution.



PASSED & EARNED HOURS

Totals for the credit hours you passed as indicated on the official transcript.



GPA HOURS & QUALITY POINTS

This is the indicated GPA hours and quality points from your prior institution. A GPA is not calculated or displayed here.



INSTITUTION LEVEL ATTEMPTED HOURS

This is the total of your institution equivalent courses on the right side of the TCE.



INSTITUTION GPA

Your NMU GPA will be calculated from the course grades you receive in enrolled NMU courses. All new students start at 0.00 GPA at the beginning of their first semester.

YOUR FIRST NEXT STEPS

BEFORE YOU GET TO NMU, TAKE CARE OF THESE ITEMS

SET UP YOUR MYNMU ACCOUNT – You've had a college email address, checked on your financial aid, and paid your tuition at your previous institution. Now is the time to set up your student account with NMU by visiting nmu.edu/admissions/activate-mynmu to get started. You need access to your account before taking any other steps to enroll at NMU. If you need help, NMU's IT HelpDesk can assist you. Call them at (906) 227–2468 if you get stuck.

SIGN UP FOR AN ORIENTATION SESSION – All new students at NMU are required to complete Orientation. We know you are familiar with how college operates and we build on that experience. Your session is designed to connect you with resources, support, and information specific to your NMU experience. There are two options for transfer students: a fully online self-paced session, or a fully in-person session. Learn more and register at **nmu.edu/orientation**

CONNECT WITH YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISER – Know your degree plan and timeline to completion before you register for your courses. Let's work together to make sure you know how your previous courses apply to your program at NMU. If you haven't connected with your academic adviser we can help – give the Admissions Office a call at (906) 227–2650 and we'll connect you.

REGISTER FOR YOUR FIRST SEMESTER AT NMU – It's time to select your courses! You'll be able to self-register for courses shortly after you complete Orientation. We recommend speaking to your academic adviser before registering for courses, to understand your options and requirements.
