## ADDITIONAL STEPS TO ENTER THE MEDICINAL PLANT CHEMISTRY PROGRAM

- At least 8 credits of the major and 4 credits of the minor must be earned at NMU. This agreement does not include a minor.
- A total of 120 credit hours with a minimum of 30 earned at NMU, and a minimum NMU GPA of 2.0 must be earned for any degree.
- Any minimum grade or GPA requirements for the major and/or minor must be met.
- NMU's General Education Program and all graduation requirements must be completed by the student, including the World Cultures requirement, Laboratory Science requirement, and Math and English Competency requirement.

This pathway is active from **July 1, 2024 - July 1, 2027**. For the full articulation agreement visit [nmu.edu/articulationagreements/](https://www.nmu.edu/articulationagreements/). Students are responsible for meeting with their academic adviser regularly to ensure they remain on track within the program as outlined in the agreement.
