## VII. New Business

- a. Art Therapy Club
  - *Taylor Phillips (President) :* We meet to improve mental health on campus, we have theme-based art activities, but anyone can come and do anything they want to do. We provide the art supplies so that it's accessible to everyone. Art supplies are expensive and that can be limiting for people. SO far we've been paying for the art supplies out of our pockets, but we've gained a lot of members so it's harder to do that. We are requesting \$100 for the semester.
  - Spencer: What are you planning on buying?
    - a) *Zyonn Costa-Adams (Treasurer):* Any kind of art supplies, like coloring books, paint, palettes, and paint brushes.
    - *b) Kaylee Bares (Vice President):* After Fall Fest, we now have 150 members and we just started last year so we grew a lot and our supplies from before are depleting.
  - *Kobie*: Do you guys have any record of the money you've spent on art supplies so far?
    *Hunter*: You can get reimbursed for that retroactively.
  - *Hunter*: I'm concerned that \$100 might not be enough. If this does get approved, you guys are always welcome to come back and ask for more.
    - a) *Eli*: \$100 for 150 members isn't a lot of money per person. It sounds like your group is growing and doing a lot of good on campus.
  - SFC Deliberation
    - a) Hunter motioned to approve Art Therapy Club's budget in full for \$100
      - Spencer second; passes unanimously

# b. Social Justice for Us

- *Freddy Sims*: I was unaware that we had to provide ground transportation and lodging for Taylor Bennett. I am asking for \$4,000 to cover Checker Transport and hotel lodging.
- *Eli*: You said this was a modification on your earlier budget, right?
  - a) Freddy: Yes, I sent you a new budget but I can send you a new adjusted one.
    We're adding \$2,500 to motor pool and \$1,500 for university guest expenses.
    The total will be \$24,000 on the budget overall.
- SFC Deliberation
  - a) Hunter motioned to pass Social Justice for Us' budget by line item
    - Spencer second; passes unanimously
  - b) *Spencer* motioned to adjust line item 7330 (University guest expenses) to the amount of \$1,500
    - Olivia second; passes unanimously
  - c) *Spencer* motioned to adjust line item 7335 (Motor Pool) to the amount of \$2,500
    - Olivia second; passes unanimously
  - d) *Hunter* motioned to approve Social Justice for Us' adjusted budget is full for the amount of \$24,000
    - *Kobie* second; passes unanimously
