IV. Executive Reports

A. President

1. Dana: "I want to thank everyone again for all the help with the Farmers Market. We really couldn't have done it without all of you. Here is just some data and feedback from the event. We had 55 vendors total, 37 of those were local vendors, and 18 were student vendors. We also had over 1,000 people attend the event over the course of the 3 hours. We got so much positive feedback from vendors saying they would love to be a part of this again when we do it. There were a lot of vendors that sold out of many things as well and were so excited about it. I am working with PR and Halle now to send out virtual thank you cards to everyone who was involved in the process as well as our vendors. I also went to the Board of Trustees Meeting and the Alumni Advisory Board Meeting last Friday. They were so excited about all the things we are doing and let me know that they would love to help in any way they can, we just need to reach out. So that is something to remember. Also, headshots are this week; Kit has sent out an email with the two dates and times that we have scheduled. Please make sure you go to one of the sessions to get your headshot taken. When I talked to Jeff Corpi last week he talked about wanting to do an ASNMU hosted formal

for the students, that would be paid for and in partnership with the Office of the President. So, we will be talking with Dr. Tessman about it and then Cindy, and then I will have more of an update for you all about it. Next, Kelly and I met with Mary about the chat with the admin event that we are trying to get going. We really just need a date and the structure of the event. We are hoping it will be a mix of a resource fair and also conversations with administrators and the President so that students can talk with people who aren't always accessible."

B. Vice President

1. Ruby: "Like Dana said I really want to thank you guys for all your help with the Farmers Market, we really appreciate it and it was an amazing event. I do have a google doc that is called 'Farmers Market Corrections'. It is just ideas and feedback I received from vendors and people who attended the event to make next year even better. If you all have anything you'd like to add, I will put the doc in our shared drive. Some of the ideas were like watering the ground the day before to help with the dust, contacting farmers this Fall about the event because they grow based on what their demand will be for the following year, providing picnic blankets by the music, advertising the tye-dye and Zumba more, sending out first round of sign ups to returning vendors so they can secure a spot first, etc. Next thing, I have a few committee that I need to make appointments for soon, so if you are interested in any of these please let me know. I need two people for the parking committee. I need one to three people for the C.U.P. or the Committee of Undergraduate Programs. And I need two to three people for the Excellence in Part Time Teaching Award Committee. Along with that, I am trying to get interviews going for new

members. We have a couple applications that I have, but I know we should have more so I am looking into where those went. I am also sending an email to the people who have joined on the Hub to let them know that the Hub is not our application and letting them know where to get that process started."

- a) Halle: "I think changing the Hub bio and Mission Statement could be a good start to making things more clear for students."

C. Treasurer

1. Victoria: "We finally got our Ten Day Numbers so for ASNMU we had a starting budget of \$1,207.68. This semester we got \$8,352.59. Leaving our total before Farmers Market, ASNMU stickers, and nametags we had \$9,560.27. After the Farmers Market and other things we are left with \$7,889.04 for the semester. That is basically all for me, but also SFC is up and running so that's amazing!"
