**C. Members with Discussion**

1. OneUP Follow-Up - Halle J., Jack B., & Dana H.

a) Halle: "Lake Superior State University (LSSU) does a sundae activity to help members learn Robert's Rules of Order. I think this is a really fun way to do it, and we should emulate that."

b) Jack: "Us and the other students governments discussed the idea of meeting more than just once a year. Possibly bi-monthly or monthly to stay in closer contact with each other and be able to learn more. Also, Michigan Tech does a Saferide Program for students on the weekends to combat drunk driving, and I think that is something ASNMU could look into."

c) Dana: "LSSU also had posters in their bathrooms with a calendar of all events for that month. It seemed weird at first but it has really worked for them to promote events. It was also talked about that one of the schools had a Presidents Council, where every student organization president met once a month and I think that could be really beneficial."

2. Group Discord - Jack Belcher

a) Jack: "Michigan Tech and LSSU use Discord to communicate rather than GroupMe. This could be an easier way for ASNMU to communicate as well. It would also make it easier for us to do voice/video calls rather than setting up a Zoom meeting each time."

b) Kelly: "I love all of you, but I do enjoy being able to separate work, school, and personal time. I do not always want to be reachable and I think this could potentially create that feeling."

c) Kit: "I would prefer Discord more as a way to get outreach for students. Discord allows you to make private channels that we could use for us, but we could also have public channels that students can join. We can then use those channels as a way of communicating with students about events, reminders, or upcoming deadlines."

d) Ivy: "I think it would be a good idea to table this for now; Jack, if you could draft a proposal we could talk about it more at that point."

3. [Faculty Evaluations](#) - Jack Belcher & Dana Hinckley

a) Jack proposes the idea of a Committee on Student Transparency that helps mediate and acknowledge student's complaints or concerns about professors. There is no communication

with students about how their Faculty Evaluations are being used or implemented.

b) Dr. Wilson provides insight from a Department Head perspective. Agreeing that student's input should be taken into account, and acknowledging the issues students are facing. He suggests that ASNMU promote the evaluation process to students and remind them how important it is to be truthful and thorough with their evaluations.
