
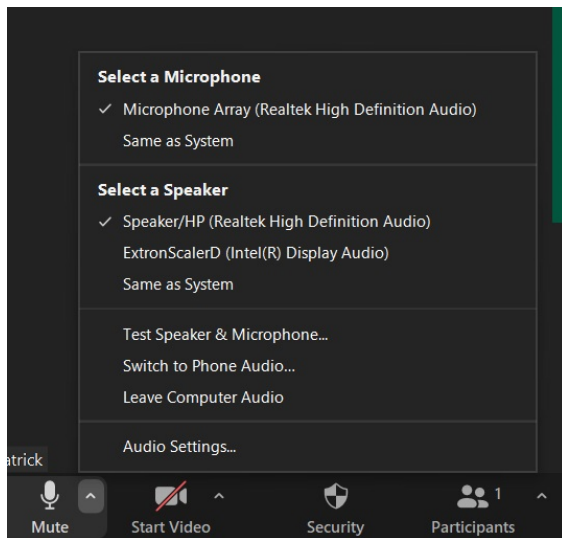
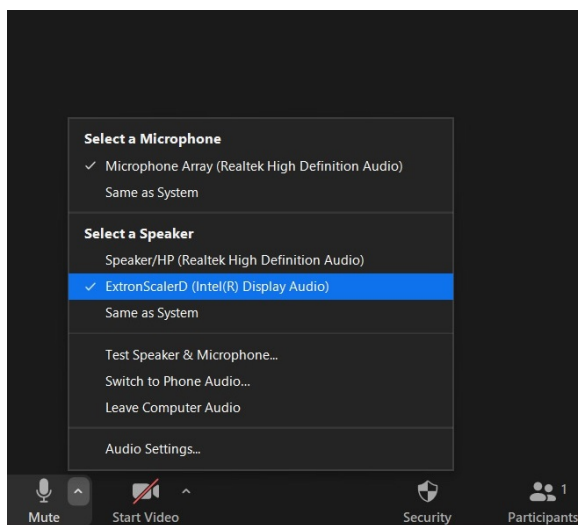


Selecting a different audio speaker in Zoom

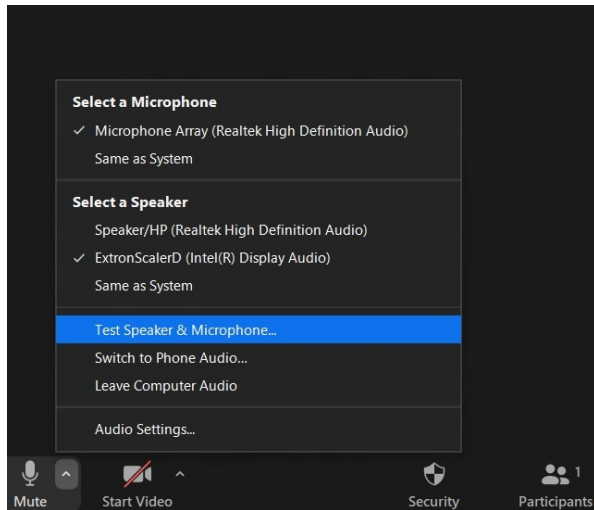
1. Connect to the AV system with the HDMI cable.
2. Start your Zoom session.
3. Click **Join Audio By Computer**.
4. Click on the ^ next to the  microphone icon in the bottom left corner of the Zoom task bar to select a different speaker.
5. You can choose to hear Zoom participants on the laptop speakers as is indicated in the graphic below.



6. You can also choose to hear the Zoom participants through the AV system's speakers. In this case, choose the output that says **"Extron ScalerD (Intel® Display Audio)"**. Keep in mind the naming of the Display Audio speaker will vary depending on the classroom and AV system.



7. After changing the speaker output, test your speaker by clicking on “**Test Speaker & Microphone**”.



8. Make sure you are selected to the HDMI input on the AV system and the volume is up and unmuted on the AV system and the laptop.
