### Objectives of CSI Certificate

- Addresses needs of students who endeavor to gain employment in law enforcement, investigations, or forensic science related fields and need to obtain the necessary specific foundational knowledge and skills.
- Students will develop knowledge and skills required to properly investigate, document, reconstruct crime scenes, and forensic evidence using scientific methods and logical analysis.
- Prepares students for securing entry level positions in the criminal justice and/or forensic science related fields.



#### Rationale / Need

- The CSI certificate will be used as a recruitment tool to increase enrollment.
- Attracts students who have an interest in solving crime and who want to work in the criminal justice, law enforcement, or forensic science fields.
- This <u>interdisciplinary academic credential</u> will serve to better prepare students for entry into their respective chosen career fields.
- The CSI certificate will make students more marketable and competitive in future entry-level and/or promotional hiring interviews.
- Job outlook for forensic science technicians projected to grow 11% from 2021 to 2031, faster than average of all occupations.
