

## MOTORCYCLE SAFETY CLASS - HOUGHTON

Welcome to Northern Michigan University's Motorcycle Safety Course in Houghton. You will start in the classroom, which will be held at the Houghton High School, 1603 Gundlach Rd. The riding sessions will be in the MTU parking Lot 23 near the Gates Tennis Center. Motorcycles will be provided.

**To be admitted to the class on Saturday, you must have an eCourse Completion Certificate and the signed liability waiver.**

**To participate in the range hours, you must wear protective clothing.**

*The sessions are on Saturday and Sunday and start at 8:00 am EST. Arrive 15 minutes early and be prepared. You will be required to have a helmet (DOT or Snell Approved), shoes (hard-soled and over-the-ankle, NO tennis shoes), long pants (denim – no synthetic fabrics), long-sleeved shirt or jacket, full-fingered gloves, and eye protection. Saturday will be classroom and riding and will last through 6 p.m., Sunday will be on the range and finish in the class with the written exam.*

There will be a lunch break on Saturday, bring a bag lunch, snacks and plenty of fluids as this weekend course is physically demanding. You will need to maintain your energy levels.
