

Google Voice Number for ReusePass

Purpose: If you want to sign up for ReusePass, but don't have access to a personal US mobile phone number, you can use a google voice number to sign up for the program.

How-To:

1. You will first need a Gmail account to set up the google voice number. If you don't have a Gmail account, it is free to sign up, and you can do so [here](#).
2. Go to voice.google.com, and select "for personal use."
3. Then select the device you will be using the phone number on. If you are using google voice because you don't have a mobile phone, then you will likely select the "web" option.
4. Next, you'll see a page where you can select your phone number. Some cities will auto-populate. Click on whichever you'd like, and you'll automatically be assigned a phone number.
5. Next, you'll be prompted to verify with an existing phone number. Here you will need to sign up for a third-party phone number service to get a temporary number to authenticate the google voice number. You can use a landline you will just need to choose the option, verify by phone.
 - a. If you have access to a mobile phone that you can use to verify the google voice number — feel free to do that! Please note this will link the Google phone number and the mobile number, but ReusePass notifications will be sent to the gmail account you used to sign up.
6. Once you have the google phone number join on app.resusepass.com!
