NEW FEES

Green Fund Fee (refundable)

The Green Fund Fee of \$5 per semester will apply for all students, and they have the option to opt-out of the fee within the first five (5) days of classes. The fee passed the student referenda with record-high voter turnout with a 76% approval rate in April 2018. The fees will be allocated to promote sustainability at NMU through programming and internal grant opportunities. Students, faculty, and staff will be able to apply for funding to launch sustainability initiatives at NMU.
