NMU Students,

Northern Michigan University continues its efforts to address negative financial impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

We previously made federal COVID relief funds, known as CARES Act funds, available through a grant process in Spring/Summer 2020 and also issued additional funds for COVID disruption relief at the beginning of the Fall 2020 semester. After disbursing those funds that were made available to qualified students through the federal CARES Act, there remains a balance. NMU is therefore disbursing the remaining balance to all qualified students.

If you were a student eligible for CARES Act funding on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the Fall 2020 semester, you will be receiving a disbursement of \$31 to assist you with on-campus COVID disruption costs that occurred in the fall semester.

Future rounds of CARES Act monies will be available later in 2021, but this will close out the 2020 federal CARES Act funding the university received. There is no obligation on the part of the students to repay CARES Act monies disbursed. You will receive notification to your NMU email account from the Financial Aid Office when the funds have been disbursed next week. The funds will be issued directly to you. They will be direct-deposited if you have this option set up in the eBill payment system. Otherwise, a check will be sent to the address on file in your NMU records.

Thank you for your continued efforts to help Northern mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
