SCHOLARSHIP NOTES:

The Wildcat Merit and Presidential Scholars awards are automatically renewed:

First year awards: Total of 8 consecutive semesters.

Transfer awards: Total of 6 consecutive semesters.

Wildcat Merit: Requires minimum cumulative 3.0 NMU GPA

Presidential Scholars awards: Requires minimum cumulative 3.0 NMU GPA.

All require full-time enrollment each semester (12 credits or more).

All are available until a first bachelor's degree is earned.
