- Amounts shown are 4 year totals, Awards earned by first year students are renewable for 8 consecutive semesters with a 3.0+ NMU GPA. Awards earned by transfer students are renewable for 6 semesters with a 3.0+ NMU GPA.

## SCHOLARSHIP NOTES:

The Bridge, Wildcat Merit and Presidential Scholars awards are automatically renewed:

**First-year awards:** Total of 8 consecutive semesters.

**Transfer awards:** Total of 6 consecutive semesters.

**Bridge:** Requires minimum cumulative 2.25 NMU GPA.

**Wildcat Merit:** Requires minimum cumulative 3.0 NMU GPA

**Presidential Scholars awards:** Requires minimum cumulative 3.0 NMU GPA.

All require full-time enrollment each semester (12 credits or more).

All are available until a first bachelor's degree is earned.
