SCHOLARSHIP NOTES

THE BRIDGE, GREAT LAKES, WILDCAT MERIT AND PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARS AWARDS ARE AUTOMATICALLY RENEWED:

- **GREAT LAKES (\$3,000):** Minimum Cumulative NMU GPA 2.5.
- **BRIDGE (\$5,600):** Minimum Cumulative NMU GPA 2.75.
- **WILDCAT MERIT (\$6,100-\$9,600):** Minimum Cumulative NMU GPA 3.0.
- Full time enrollment (12+ credits).
- Renewable for 6 (transfers) or 8 (first-year) semesters or until 1st bachelor's degree, whichever comes first.
