Talent Recognition Awards: Amounts awarded vary for students in art/design, music and theater.

STANDARD FEES

Not included in annual cost example

-  **Recreation Pass:** \$85 per semester (refundable through 5th day of semester)
-  **Green Fund Fee:** \$5 per semester (refundable through 5th day of semester)
-  **Athletic Fee:** \$265 (one time fee)
-  **Art & Design Technology Fee:** \$250/semester (includes a MacBook, Art & Design students only)

OTHER EXPENSES

Families should also consider these additional expenses, which vary by student:

-  Textbooks and supplies
-  Transportation and personal expenses
-  **P** Parking pass (optional: \$140 per year)
-  Course/lab program fees (varies by course)
