When answering the following questions count only federal or state convictions. Do not count any convictions that have been removed from your record, or that occurred before you turned 18, unless you were tried as an adult.

Table with 11 rows and 2 columns. Row 1: Have you ever received federal student aid? YES - go to question 2, NO - complete signature section. Row 2: Have you been convicted for possessing or selling illegal drugs for an offense that occurred while you were receiving federal student aid? YES - go to question 3, NO - complete signature section. Row 3: Did the offense for possessing or selling illegal drugs occur during a period of enrollment for which you were receiving federal student aid? YES - go to question 4, NO - complete signature section. Row 4: Have you completed an acceptable drug rehabilitation program since your conviction? YES - complete signature section, NO - go to question 5. Row 5: Do you have more than two convictions for possessing illegal drugs? YES - complete signature section, NO - go to question 6. Row 6: Do you have more than one conviction for selling illegal drugs? YES - complete signature section, NO - go to question 7. Row 7: Write the date of your last conviction for possessing illegal drugs: Go to question 8. Row 8: If you have only one conviction for possessing drugs, add one year to the date in question 7, and write that date here, or If you have two convictions for possessing drugs, add two years to the date in question 7 and write that date here: Row 9: Write the date of your last conviction for selling illegal drugs here: Go to question 10. Row 10: If you only have one conviction for selling drugs, add two years to the date in question 9, and write that date here: Row 11: Look at the dates you wrote in questions 8 and 10. If there is only one date, write that date here. If there are two dates, write the later date here. This is your eligibility date.

If you are convicted of possessing or selling drugs after you have submitted your FAFSA, you must notify NMU's Financial Aid Office immediately. You will lose your eligibility and must pay back all aid you received after your conviction.
