Testing is done daily from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. with an appointment. Bring insurance card and ID.

Walgreen's offers free at-home collection kits for pick-up as well as drive-thru testing options of PCR lab tests, rapid NAAT tests, and rapid antigen tests. For pharmacy drive-thru tests, you schedule your date/time on the website. No doctor order is needed. Result times vary; generally, 1-3 days. Bring insurance card and ID.
