ONCE YOU HAVE BEEN ADMITTED INTO THE MASTER'S IN ATHLETIC TRAINING PROGRAM - ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS (rev. 4/24)

Once a student has been admitted into the master's in athletic training program, he or she will be required to complete the following:

1. Provide a final copy of an official transcript indicating that the student has successfully completed all required prerequisites.

THE FOLLOWING WILL BE COMPLETED ONCE THE STUDENT HAS ARRIVED ON CAMPUS AND HAS BEGUN THE PROGRAM (FIRST SUMMER OF ENROLLMENT).

- 1. <u>Proof of a negative drug screen</u>. This ONLY NEEDS TO BE COMPLETED if a specific clinical site requires it. This will be completed at the student's expense. (EX: Immersive internship at a major health system may require drug screen)
- 2. <u>A criminal background check.</u> This will be completed through the NMU background check system at no cost to the student.

Additional in-depth screenings may be required by specific clinical sites. This will be at the students expense. (EX: Immersive internship at a major health system may require fingerprinting)

- 3. As a part of the program application process, students are required to provide vaccination records. In addition, student will be required to complete the following annually:
 - a. Influenza vaccination. This will be at the student's expense.
 - b. TB skin test. This will be at the student's expense.
 - *Both of these are available through the NMU Student Health Center on campus.
- 4. <u>Proof of current certification in CPR/AED</u> at the health-care provider level. Refresher courses will be offered to students as needed. Students will be responsible for the costs of books and cards. Refresher courses will be offered at no cost to the student.
- 5. Students admitted into the master's in athletic training program will be required to participate in the following training sessions:
 - a. HIPAA
 - b. FERPA
 - c. Bloodborne Pathogens
- 5. Students admitted into the master's in athletic training program will be required to complete/sign the following programmatic forms (failure to sign these forms may preclude students from participation in the clinical component of the AT program):

- a. Communicable Disease Policy form
- b. Non-disclosure of Medical Information form
- c. CAATE Waiver form
- d. Program Policy & Procedure form
- f. Other program forms deemed necessary by the program.

NOTE: All above items MUST be completed before the student is permitted to participate in any formal AT clinical experience courses.
