Northern Michigan University's Department of Psychological Science delivers this degree for a basic understanding of the field of psychology. Students complete a number of advanced psychology courses selected to address their individual interests, professional goals, and preparation for graduate programs in psychology.

## TIME WITH NICOLET

Students may earn any associate degree from Nicolet College before enrolling in the online psychology program at NMU and may transfer up to ninety (90) credit hours. Unless otherwise designated, a grade of at least a C- is required for courses to be considered for transfer to Northern.

During the first two years at Nicolet, students will complete courses to meet the General Education curriculum requirements at NMU. In addition, students will take courses that may be transferred in for Psychology credits and used toward the completion of requirements for the Psychology Major.

Students may also choose to concentrate in a particular subject area at Nicolet College in order to use those courses toward a minor at NMU—but this is not required.
