## 3 + 3 LEGAL EDUCATION ADMISSION PROGRAM

An accelerated degree option between the Northern Michigan University  
and Michigan State University College of Law

**The 3 + 3 Legal Education Admission Program (LEAP) allows NMU students to use credits earned during their first year at MSU Law to meet undergraduate degree requirements.**

LEAP offers NMU students an opportunity to minimize the cost of their education and begin their legal careers one year sooner.

To be considered for admission to LEAP, NMU students must:

- Matriculate at NMU as first-year students
- Consult with a LEAP advisor during their freshman or sophomore year to discuss their educational and career goals
- Complete a minimum of 91 credits at NMU
- Earn a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 3.60 or higher and receive a score of 153 or higher on the Law School Admission Test
- Apply for admission to MSU Law on or before February 1 of their junior year

LEAP applicants receive an admission decision within one month of submitting their application to MSU Law and are considered for all levels of scholarship and grant assistance.
