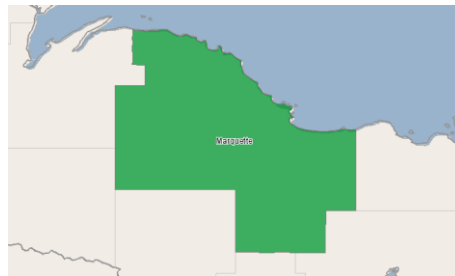

Data Sources and Calculations

In/Out Migration Data

The In/Out Migration data in this report comes from the Internal Revenue Service, specifically the Statistics of Income Division's County-to-County Migration Data.

Housing Units Data

The Housing Units data in this report is taken from the U.S. Census Bureau, Population Division, Housing Units Estimates.

Median Rent Data

EMSI's Median Rent Data comes from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, specifically the 50th Percentile Rent Estimates from the Office of Policy Development and Research.

Occupation Data

Organizing regional employment information by occupation provides a workforce-oriented view of the regional economy. EMSI's occupation data are based on EMSI's industry data and regional staffing patterns taken from the Occupational Employment Statistics program (U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics). Wage information is partially derived from the American Community Survey. The occupation-to-program (SOC-to-CIP) crosswalk is based on one from the U.S. Department of Education, with customizations by EMSI.

Proprietors Data

The Proprietors data in this report comes from Local Area Personal Reports from the Bureau of Economic Analysis at the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Patents Data

The Patents Data in this report comes from the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office.

Educational Attainment Data

EMSI's educational attainment numbers are based on Census 1990, Census 2000, the Current Population Survey, and EMSI's demographic data. By combining these sources, EMSI interpolates for missing years and projects data at the county level. Educational attainment data cover only the population aged 25 years or more and indicate the highest level achieved.

State Data Sources

This report uses state data from the following agencies: Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth, Bureau of Labor Market Information and Strategic Initiatives.
