



### Factors Impacting Higher Education

- New Administration
- Division of Power
  - Senate 22-16
  - House 58-52
- Relatively new legislature
  - 2/3 of House freshman never held elected office; youngest House
  - 7 of 38 Senate members never held office
  - Varied backgrounds: Small business, teachers, military background, lawyers
  - Subcommittee Structure
    - Combined with Community Colleges
    - New Chair in House, Senator LaSata

### Formula Funding

# FY2019 State formula factors for appropriation increase

- One-half increase ATB based on 2010-11 appropriation level (50%)
- One-half based on Performance funding factors (50%):
  - Number of critical skills degrees (22.2%)
  - Research and Development expenditures (11.2%)
  - Metrics based on Carnegie Peers (national metrics)
     (66.6%)

#### Carnegie Peer Factors increase

- o 6-year graduation rate
- Total degree completions
- Institutional support as percentage of core expenditures
- o Percentage of students receiving Pell grants

### Formula Funding

#### **Current formula**

- Combination of formula and ATB to determine increase in appropriation
  - ½ increase is ATB % on base appropriation
  - ½ increase based on performance metrics

#### Past formula proposals and models

- Funding floors
- Funding tiers
- Flat dollar appropriation per student
- o Include vs. exclude graduate students in counts
- In-state only allocation per FTE
- o Formula for increase vs total formula base appropriation

#### **Tuition Restraint**

#### **Tuition Restraint Language FY2019**

- Tuition restraint: 3.8% or (\$490)
- O State instituted a hard dollar cap in 2019 to address funding issue for universities with lower tuition rates
- Maintained penalties:
  - Lose appropriation increase
  - Not eligible for capital outlay for 2 years
  - Can be penalized or have university appropriations adjusted at any time

### School Aid Fund

#### School Aid Fund (SAF)

Established in 1955 (K-12)

1994 Proposal A Sales Tax Increase, 4% to 6% K-12

2009 Gov. Granholm "borrowed"

Since 2011, increase in amount used for higher education, cc's


