Tuition & Fees

Gavin Leach and Sherri Towers discussed tuition and fees. Tuition monies go to the general fund; summer monies go back to the department (and that will not change). Steve VandenAvond stated that online tuition rates are per online program. NMU Global Campus is strictly online students/online classes only for an entire degree program. Brad Hamel is the 'concierge' for online programs. Tuition from online classes goes to each specific department.

EAN

We received a 6.5 million dollar loan from MEDC, and every dollar will be spent to help buildout the LTE network across the Upper Peninsula. We plan to service 64 sites in the next two years, and all of them have schools identified. Four schools are ready to go live—Escanaba, Watersmeet, Crystal Falls, and Chatham/Eben.
