**Complete a minimum of 30 semester credit hours in residence at Northern Michigan University, excluding advanced placement credit. Transfer students must earn a minimum of eight credits in each major and four credits in each minor.**

## Recommendation for Teacher Certification Programs

- Completion of all coursework;
- Maintain an overall GPA of at least 2.7 (B-) in all ECE Coursework;
- A minimum of 300 clinical hours of supervised internship in an early childhood setting;
- Passing score on the MI Teacher Test for Certification #134 Early Childhood General and Special Education (Birth-K).



This pathway is active from December 1, 2025 - December 1, 2028.
