THIRD YEAR & FOURTH YEARS AT NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY

On-Campus students must choose one of the following concentrations: Interdisciplinary Psy, Brain & Behavior Psy, Developmental Psy, Mental Health/Pre-Clinical Psy, Social Personality Psy, Cognitive & Behavioral Psy

Global online students must choose one of the following concentrations: Interdisciplinary Psy or Mental Health/Pre-Clinical Psy

Fall Semester

- PSY 160 Seminar for Psychology Majors
- PSY 201 Psychological Research I
- PSY 230 Learning & Cognition
- PSY 250 Brain & Behavior or PSY 251 Topics on Brain & Behavior

Winter Semester

- PSY 202 Psychological Research II
- Meet with adviser and select concentration courses
- Concentration Course/Elective/Optional Minor Course

If concentration courses are met & a minor is not selected, student must select electives to meet the 120-credit degree requirement.

Complete a minimum of 30 semester hours of credit in residence at Northern Michigan University, excluding advanced placement credit.

Fall Semester

- Concentration Course
- Meet with your adviser to determine what additional courses may be needed for the selected concentration or optional minor due to possible transfer credit deficiencies.
- One course must meet the Global Citizenship Grad Req if not taken at Gogebic Community College. See adviser.

Winter Semester

- PSY 489 Graduate Assessment for Psychology Majors
- Meet with your adviser to determine what additional courses may be needed for the selected concentration or optional minor due to possible transfer credit deficiencies.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAM

- At least 8 credits of the major and 4 credits of the minor must be earned at NMU. This agreement does not include a minor.
- A total of 120 credit hours with a minimum of 30 earned at NMU, and a minimum NMU GPA of 2.0 must be earned for any degree.
- Any minimum grade or GPA requirements for the major and/or minor must be met. Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.25 based on all course work applied to the Psychology curriculum.
- NMU's General Education Program and all graduation requirements must be completed by the student, including the Global Citizenship requirement, Laboratory Science requirement, and Math and English Competency requirement.
