

**Emergency Medical Technician/Paramedic to
Associate Degree Program in General Studies
Articulation Agreement**

This articulation agreement, which is effective on the date of the final signature, provides transfer admission opportunities for graduates of the UP HEALTH SYSTEM MARQUETTE Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Program who are academically qualified and interested in completing an Associate Degree at NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY. Students must complete all 11 transferrable modules and receive their EMT Paramedic Certificate to transfer a maximum of 8 credits to NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY. Students will then take a minimum of 52 credits at NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY, as specified in the accompanying degree plan table for an Associate's Degree in General Studies. Other college transfer credits, in addition to these 11 modules, may be reviewed on an individual basis consistent with NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY policy.

Terms of Agreement:

1. The Paramedic Program students (graduates) accepted to NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY will receive a maximum of 8 transfer credits for the successful completion of their EMT-Paramedic Certificate deemed comparable (based on current course description information, course requirements, and agreement by the representatives of the respective programs) to current SCHOOL OF HEALTH AND HUMAN PERFORMANCE courses.
2. Based on placement testing, the transfer student may be required to complete developmental courses in English or mathematics prior to enrolling in a program's graduation requirements in those disciplines. Also, the transfer student must complete all prerequisite courses for upper-level courses.
3. This agreement shall include those students who are currently enrolled in the UP HEALTH SYSTEM MARQUETTE Paramedic Training Program commencing in May 2023 and thereafter. (Prior graduates may be admitted on an individual basis consistent with NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY policy.)
4. This agreement may be terminated by either party at any time; however, enrolled students will be permitted to complete their course of study consistent with this Agreement. NORTHERN MICHIGAN may modify program and degree requirements at any time. UP HEALTH SYSTEM MARQUETTE and NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY agree to notify one another of program changes that might affect the transfer of students under this agreement.
5. Both organizations agree to the right to use each other's names in print and media advertising for the purpose of marketing the programs, described herein. All materials must be approved by the respective communications and/or marketing offices at the partner institution.
6. UP HEALTH SYSTEM MARQUETTE agrees to provide NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY student information for the express purpose of contacting UP HEALTH SYSTEM graduates directly regarding the degree program between the two institutions described in this Articulation Agreement in compliance with all state and federal laws

including, but not limited to, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA, 20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99), with regard to the confidentiality of student records.

7. This agreement is predicated on the satisfactory, and continued, accreditation of UP HEALTH SYSTEM MARQUETTE by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) upon the recommendation of the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Profession (CoAEMSP).
8. Neither party shall be responsible for costs, fees or other payments of any kind to the other party.

UP HEALTH SYSTEM and NORTHERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY, recognizing the importance of providing seamless coordination between the respective institutions, hereby enter into an Articulation Agreement.
