ALL STUDENTS MUST UNDERSTAND:

- Always check your NMU email; This is the only way the NMU Veteran Services office can officially contact you.
- Eligibility, rates, and frequency of payments are determined solely by the VA.
- □ You should complete a FAFSA for every academic year at www.FAFSA.gov by March 1st if possible.
- Remember, student loans are a debt you must repay! Never use more student loans than you absolutely need. Carefully review the information on www.studentloans.gov if you decide to borrow.
- An Enrollment Verification Form must be completed and submitted with a copy of your degree evaluation as soon as you enroll for upcoming semesters before our office can certify your enrollment to the VA.
- □ VA regulations mandate that **only courses required for your degree program** will be certified to the VA as part of your enrollment. Meet with an academic advisor on a regular basis.
- □ You are responsible for your outstanding balance with the University whether or not you are expecting, or have received, GI Bill® education benefits payments. VA payment delays are not uncommon. While our office, and the University, make every effort to work with students, please have a back-up plan in place for tuition payments, living expenses, etc., should your VA benefits payments be delayed, reduced, or denied.
- □ Full-time status is 12 certifiable credits for undergraduate students, and 8 credits for graduate students. Summer enrollment has a different benefit and billing structure; therefore, benefits may vary widely as a result.
- Non-standard enrollment periods (classes that do not run for the entire semester) may affect your be nefits.
- Our office is required to monitor and report changes in your enrollment to the VA. If you drop, withdraw from, or stop attending a class, you will be responsible for any overpayment of GI Bill® or Federal Title IV (FAFSA) funds to the VA and/or the University.
- We will not answer questions about your benefits, status, enrollment, or grades to anyone other than you, an authorized university, or VA personnel. We cannot give that information to parents, spouses, etc.

CHAPTER 33®:

- □ VA Payments for tuition and fees come directly to the school. Housing allowance and book stipend payments are sent directly to the student. Book stipends are prorated over 24 credit hours/year.
- □ You are responsible for any difference between actual tuition charges and your percentage of e ligibility.
- Housing allowance payments are prorated based on your percentages of eligibility and enrollment level, which are paid in arrears. You must also verify your attendance each month with the VA to receive the MHA. These instructions are provided seperately.
- Depending on your individual financial aid status, Title IV (FAFSA) funds may not be released until your tuition payment from the VA is received by the school; usually about three weeks into the semester. This could delay any overage payment you may be expecting. Please plan accordingly.
- The total that all tuition assistance programs that a student receives may not exceed the tuition/fees cost of NMU. Tuition/fee sensitive awards, such as the National Guard Grant, Michigan National State Tuition Assistance Program (MINGSTAP), Michigan Competitive Scholarship, Army Continuing Education System (ACES), Federal Tuition Assistance, Indian Tuition Waivers, NMU Faculty Staff Tuition Waivers, ROTC Scholarship, Police Academy Scholarship, etc., may be subject to adjustment, or affect other aid.

CHAPTER 30®, 1606®

- □ VA payments will be sent directly to you. You are responsible for paying your NMU bill, whether or not your VA benefit covers the entire cost of your education.
- □ You must verify your enrollment at the end of every month with the VA. Call 877-823-2378 or go online to_www.gibill.va.gov/wave.
- Your monthly benefit will be prorated based on your enrollment in certifiable credits, which is paid in arrears.
- The total that all tuition assistance programs that a student receives may not exceed the tuition/fees cost of NMU. Tuition/fee sensitive awards, such as the National Guard Grant, Michigan National State Tuition Assistance Program (MINGSTAP), Michigan Competitive Scholarship, Army Continuing Education System (ACES), Federal Tuition Assistance, Indian Tuition Waivers, NMU Faculty Staff Tuition Waivers, ROTC Scholarship, Police Academy Scholarship, etc., may be subject to adjustment, or affect other aid.

CHAPTER 35

- □ VA payments will be sent directly to you. You are responsible for paying your NMU bill, whether or not your VA benefit covers the entire cost of your education.
- Your monthly benefit will be prorated based on your enrollment in certifiable credits, which is paid in arrears
- You may be required to verify your enrollment to the VA. If required, you will receive verification directly from the VA by mail with instructions on how to apply.

CHAPTER 31®

- Our office must receive both the purchase order (from your VRE counselor) *and* an Enrollment Verification Form (from you, the student) *every semester* you wish to use your benefits.
- □ Your monthly benefit will be prorated based on your enrollment in certifiable credits.
- Your schedule, transcript, degree evaluation, and other relevant educational information will be shared with your VRE counselor when requested.
